

"This time I was on the street hungry and looking for an open window where I could get in and get some food." He was arrested for burglary and sent to jail but he found God there. "One day I overheard two inmates talking about God and it gave me that thirst—that drive to read the Word." When he got out of jail he found a bicycle and started riding, making his way to Florida. "I thought I would stop in Virginia to hook up with some friends to help me get some money." It took him six days to get here. "God blessed me the entire way. I was so tired on that highway but He started pedaling for me."

Looking for shelter, he met a guy who told him "God had planned this" and pointed him to The Union Mission. "That bike ride was the first step in my journey of getting closer to God when I had no choice but to leave it in His hands. Part of the way I didn't know where to go, and He guided me. Part of the way I wanted to give up and He gave me the strength. When I wasn't sure where to put my focus He said, 'Leave it in My hands'. I didn't have to worry about food or something to drink; He provided.

I didn't want to stay at the Mission at first, but it was good to have a bed and a shower. I thought; 'How can I get a job when I'm homeless, practically a bum? Who is here to back me up?' Then the David Development Program opened up and my light turned on. God has

Thomas shared his desire to become an aviation mechanic with Mr. Metcalf, who helped him apply to the Aviation Institute of Maintenance. He started school in May and says he is proud that he's a straight "A" student but, "I'm focusing on the Word. It's making me so much better than I used to be. God has been immensely good to me. He brought me through jail, my bike ride, to school, and to the Mission. I can't hold the joy in. I don't know where I'd be if it wasn't for the Mission."
